### Context and Objectives

DigiFoodEdu was born within the **coronavirus crisis** era as teachers and students had to adapt to new ways of distance teaching and learning, developing **new pedagogical practices based on digital education**.

DigiFoodEdu aims to:

- foster the **development of digital skills and exchange of good pedagogical practices in the digital era**
- **study the practices put in place during the pandemic**
- come up with a **best practices guide for education improvement in the digital era**.

Ultimately, the project aims to modernize pedagogical practices used for teaching and supporting students during their project-based learning activities.

## Results of the project

During the last 2 years, we studied the pedagogical practices developed during the COVID-19 era.

The **first year was dedicated to the survey** by disseminating questionnaires and organizing focus groups and interviews with Universities' professors and students, and professionals from the food sector.

The **second year was dedicated to the testing of the pedagogical practices** identified and writing a **Whitebook** including the results of this project and the best pedagogical practices. We also developed **3 videos** to summarize the project results!

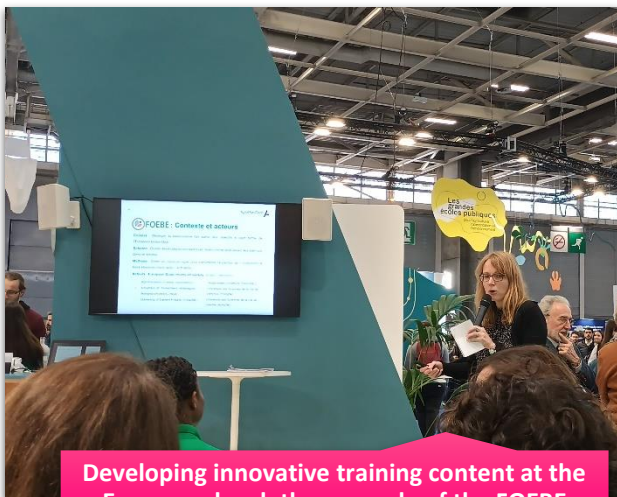
