Getting started with InCites

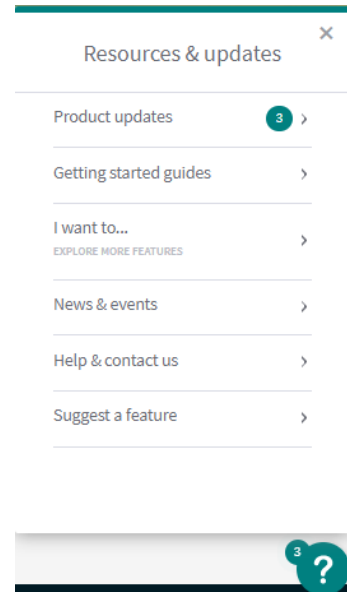

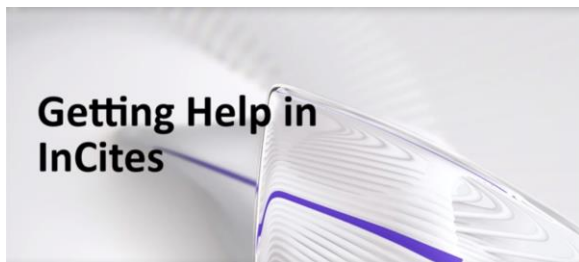
