Contents: In 2020 the focus will be on invasive alien wood species. The

students will produce small table-top sized objects. The main requirement is that invasive alien wood in any form (solid wood, disintegrated wood /wood particles, chips, etc./, liquefied wood) is the main component of the object. The predominant component should be combined with other materials (e.g. polymers either in a solid form, a coating layer, etc; or fibers and fiber containing materials, or glass or metal), so that in a composite interface between two materials could be studied/characterised. The interface property should be selected in such a way that it is shown that it is a very important one for the object prepared with an applicative value, and its determination can be performed by a method available in the laboratories of the Department of Wood

Science & Technology.

How and when to apply: The call for applications will be issued until the end of May (News

on the site of Wood Science & Technology Department). 8 places available. In the case of too many applications, the candidates will be selected on the first come first served principle. In addition, the following priorities will be regarded, also taking into account that the students have not attended this summer school in previous years: 1.
