But, with the enormous effort of our course coordinators, we are very proud of the over 60 courses offered in an online format!

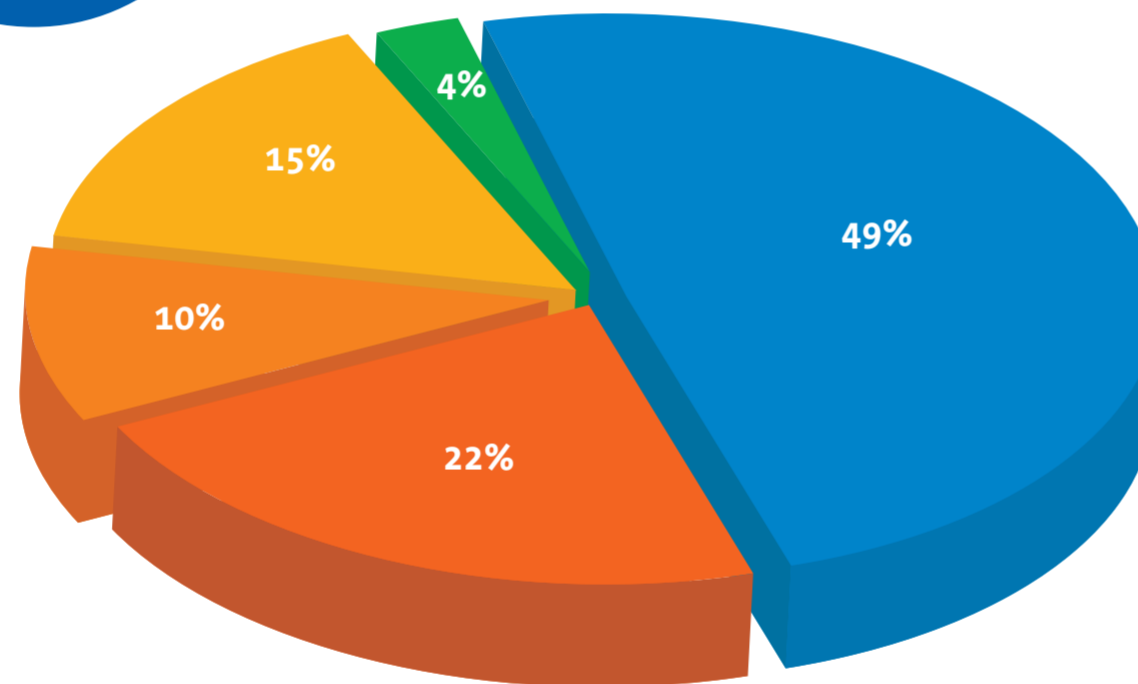
