- Interactive innovation as applied to farming and forestry

- Roles of the advisor in the innovation process (the Spiral of Innovations and the Triangle of co-creation)
- Networking and facilitation

The participants will also benefit from the presence of experienced advisors with whom they will discuss real cases of interactive innovation and/or field visits (if appropriate).

SUMMER SCHOOL BUDGET

Participants will have to cover their travel costs and accommodation (35 Euros per night, including breakfast).

The summer school will cover the expenses of trainers, classrooms, and training materials, as well as all participants' coffee-breaks and lunches.
